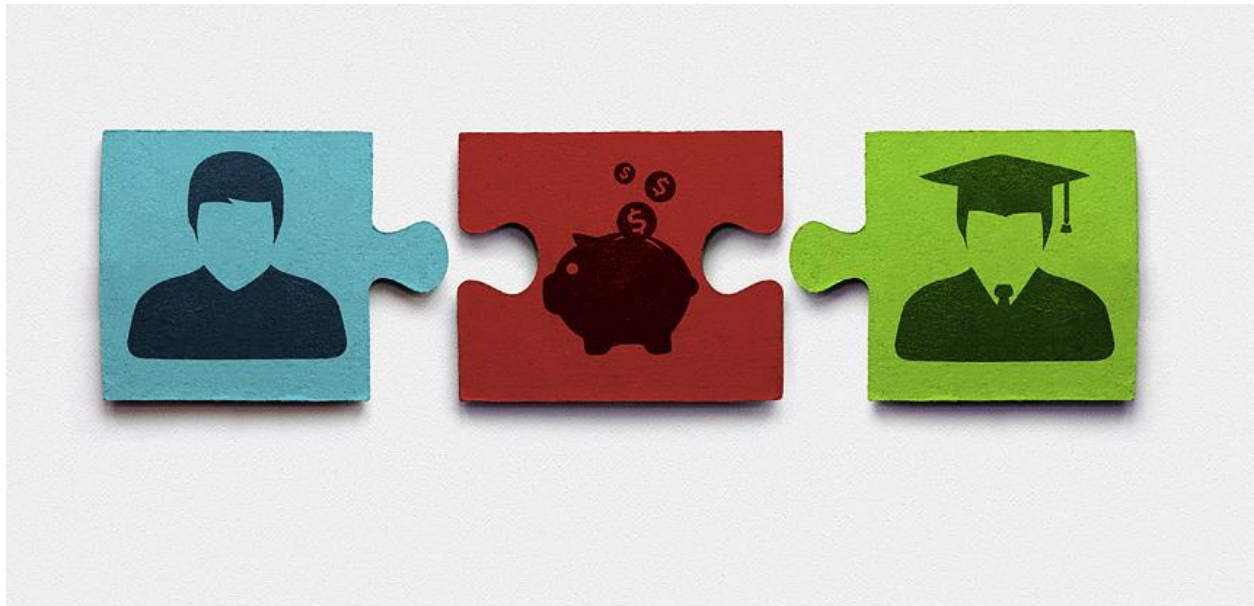


What Do I Need to Apply for 2020/2021 Financial Aid?



Ideally, the student & a parent + the information below

- Your Social Security number and Driver's License or State ID
- Your Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals number – if you have one
- Your [FSA ID](#) –if you have one
- Your parent's [FSA ID](#) – if they have one
- Your 2018 Federal Income Tax Return and W2's – if available
- Your parent(s) 2018 Federal Income Tax Return and W2's - if available
- Any record of untaxed income such as disability benefits, child support, and military or clergy benefits.
- Your permanent resident number (if you are not a US citizen).
